DEFINITION OF HEALTH CARE WORKER

All health care providers, health service providers, support staff working within ancillary services within a health care, mental health, or addictions treatment setting, and paramedics.

TEMPORARY STAFF ACCOMMODATIONS (TSA)

The Ministry of Health is supporting Health Authorities to provide temporary staff accommodations (TSA) for health care workers working in active COVID patient care and staff who do not provide patient care but are assigned to a key COVID response role. Please note: Any IH staff member (including Physicians) who does not meet the criteria for funded temporary accommodation, are welcome to send a request in through IHCOVIDCallCentreTeam@interiorhealth.ca and the team will reserve a discounted hotel room for them through a self-pay option

FOR IH HEALTH CARE WORKERS

Temporary accommodation will be provided until otherwise communicated, subject to availability, to eligible health care workers who meet any of the following criteria as outlined in the Memo-Temporary Staff Accommodation

• APPLICATION AND APPROVAL PROCESS

The application can be accessed <u>here</u>, completed by the employee/medical staff and submitted to Manager/Dept. Head for approval that the eligibility requirements are met. The Manager/ Dept. Head forwards the approved application to IHCOVIDCallCentreTeam@interiorhealth.ca and the team will book the room and notify the health care worker (see key timelines on application form).

FOR FIRST RESPONDERS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF PHSA

Temporary accommodation will be provided until otherwise communicated, subject to availability, to eligible health care workers who meet any of the following criteria as outlined in the PHSA 'Temporary Accommodation for Essential Workers Section'

APPLICATION AND APPROVAL PROCESS

- If you meet one of the criteria, please complete the application here. Once you have submitted this application form, your information will be saved in our database and you do not need to resubmit this form for subsequent TEPA requests.
- o If the above eligibility criteria do not apply to you but you would still like to access temporary accommodation, please consider our Self Paid Temporary Staff Accommodation Program, which provides a list of hotels and apartments, offering a range of options which you can access at a significant PHSA discount during the COVID response.
